

Asia is one of the continents of the world and like most other continents, is divided into parts known as Countries. Look at the map of Asia. In the southern part of the continent there is a region called the Indo-Pakistan Sub-continent. Find in this region your own country—PAKISTAN.

SIZE AND BOUNDARIES OF PAKISTAN

Pakistan is situated between the latitudes of 23° 30′ and 36° 45′ north and between the longitudes of 60° and 75° 31′ east. It comprises four provinces; Baluchistan, North West Frontier Province, Sindh and the Punjab. The largest in size is Baluchistan. It has an area of 347,188 square km. It is followed by the Punjab with an area of 206,251 square km. Next in size is Sindh which covers an area of 140,913 square km. The smallest in size is the North West Frontier Province (N.W.F.P.) comprising an area of 74,522 square km. The Federally Administered Tribal Areas (F.A.T.A.) cover 27,221 square km. The total area of the country is 796,095 square km.

Pakistan is bordered by Afghanistan and China in the north and by India in the east. In the west it is hugged by Afghanistan and Iran. The Arabian Sea lies to the south of it.
