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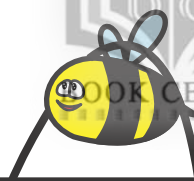


# A Triangle

Things you need:

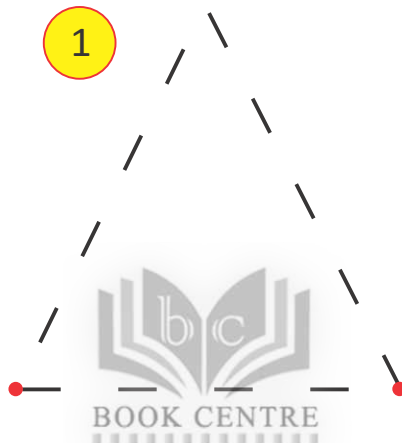


- Join the dots and complete the triangles.

## A Sweet Corncob

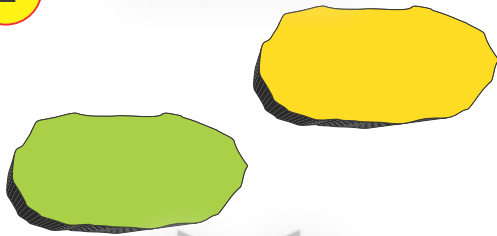


Fun with Play-dough.

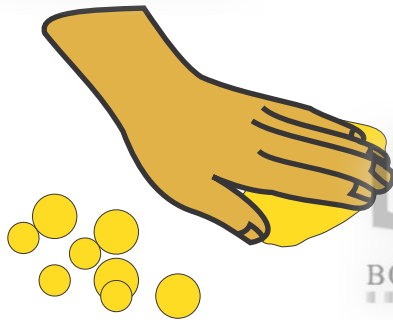
Take play-dough of two different colours e.g., yellow and green.

2



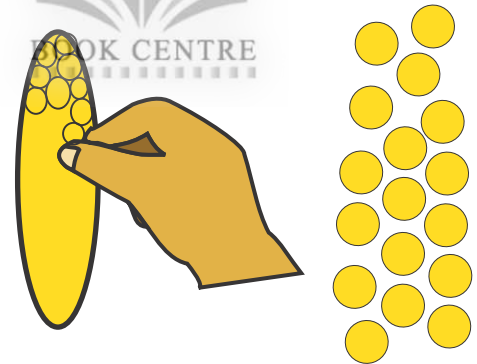
Take half of the yellow play-dough and spread it in an oval shape with help of your palm.

Make small balls of the remaining half of the play-dough with your palm.

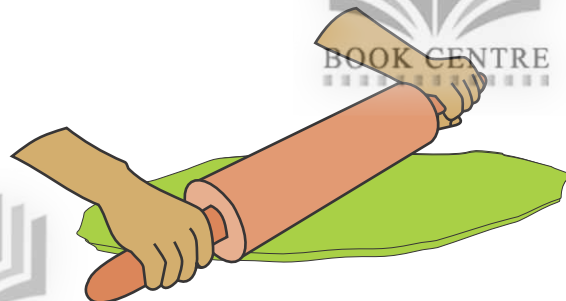

Attach the balls onto the oval shape like this. Your corncob is now ready.

Take the green play-dough. Spread it on your desk with the help of a rolling pin.



*Note for Teachers: Teachers should guide the children as how to roll green play-dough on the table with a rolling pin to give it an oval shape.*



# A Pinwheel

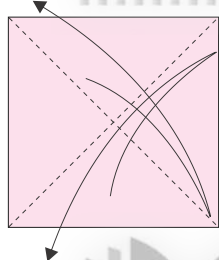


Paper Folding and Cutting.

Things you need:

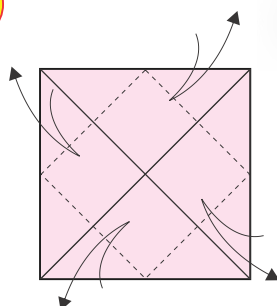

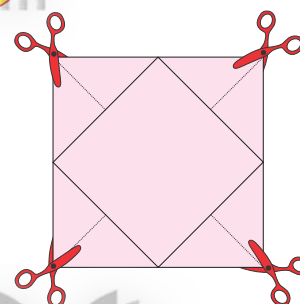
Make two creases to mark the centre of the paper.

2



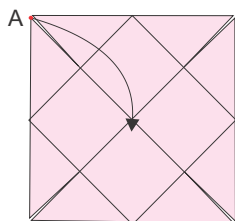
Fold in all the corners to meet at the centre to make four creases. Unfold them.

Cut at all the four corners as shown here.

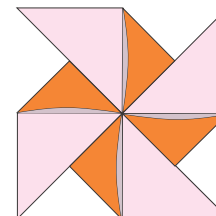


Fold cut corner "A" to meet at the centre.

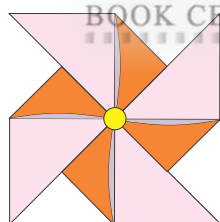


Fold all cut corners to meet at the centre.

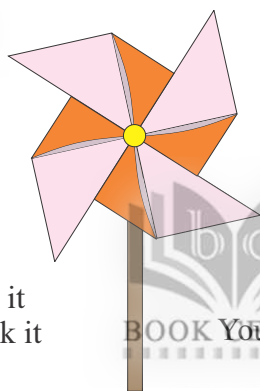


It will look like this.

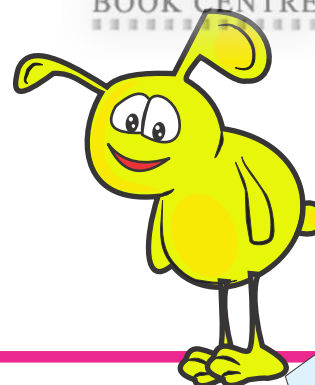

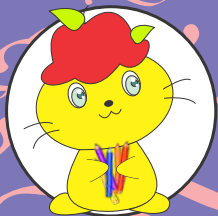
Take a drawing pin and pierce it through the pin wheel and stick it to your wooden ruler.



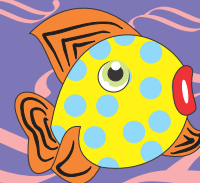
Your Pinwheel is ready.







# Eggshell People



Using Waste Material.

Things you need:

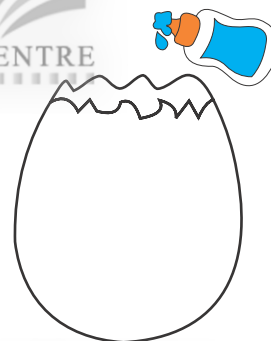

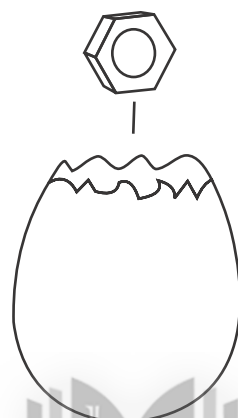
Crack open one end of an egg.  
Empty it.

After the shell has dried,  
pour a little glue inside.

3



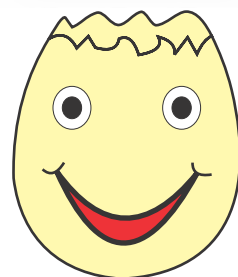
Drop a nut or an eraser inside,  
it will stick to the base itself.

Colour the shell.

Draw eyes and mouth.

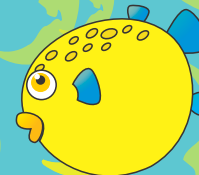

Put some black paper strips  
to make its hair. Other eggshell  
people can be made in this way.



# Half Cutting

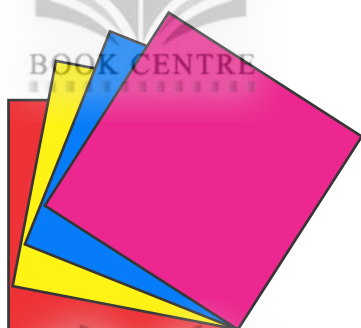


Cutting and Pasting.

Things you need:

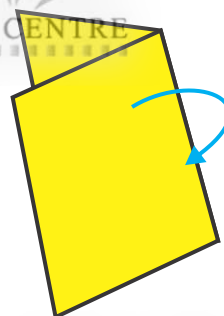

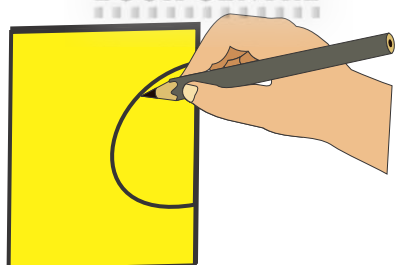
Take a glazed paper of any colour of your choice.

2



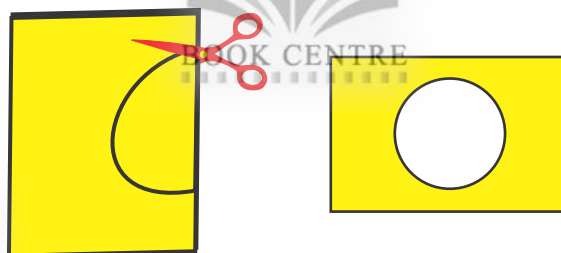
Fold the paper at the centre.

Now draw a half circle at the fold of the paper.

Take a pair of scissors and cut along the line you drew earlier. You will get a full circle, when you unfold the paper.

You may draw other shapes in this way.
