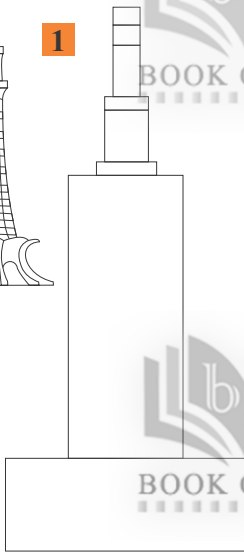
# Our Minar-e-Pakistan

Things you need:

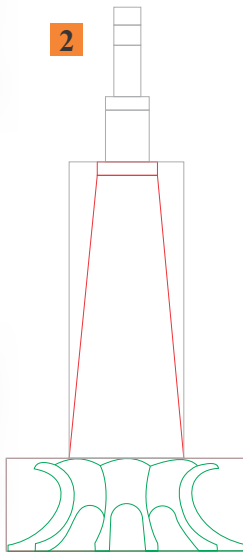

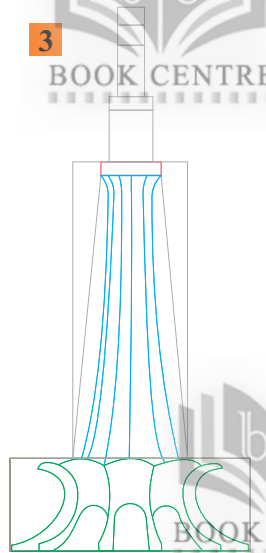
We can see a number of rectangles standing upwards on a rectangular platform.

2



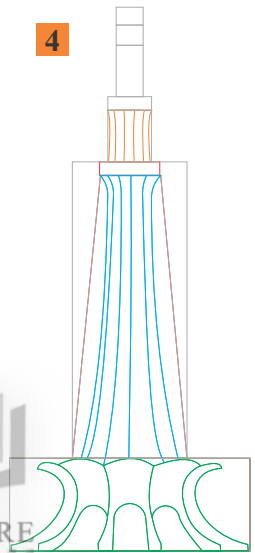
Convert the platform in a flower like shape. Give a little shape to the first rectangle.

3



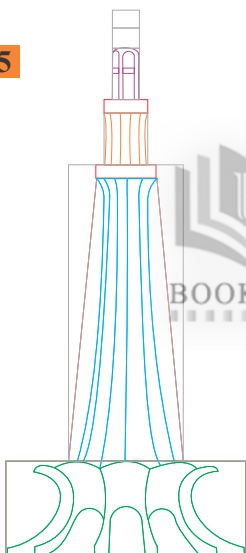
Now it is easy to give details of the first rectangle.

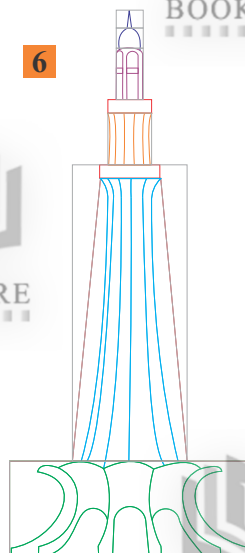
We can give shape to the second and third rectangles.

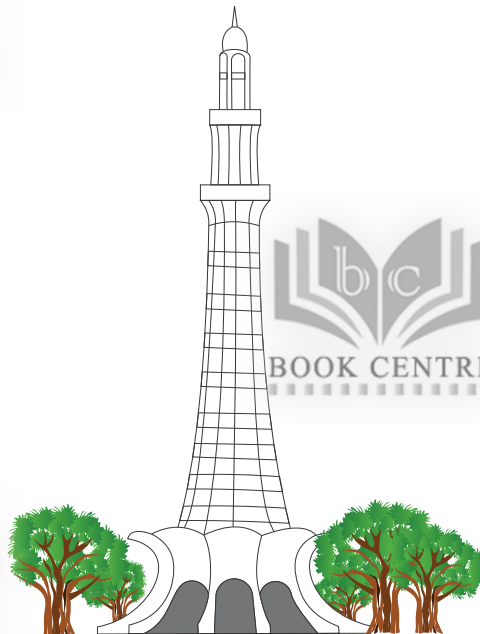


Now we can add a dome at the top.

Looking minutely we should add horizontal lines to complete Minar-e-Pakistan. Add a needle to the dome.



If we add a few trees it will beautify our Minar-e-Pakistan



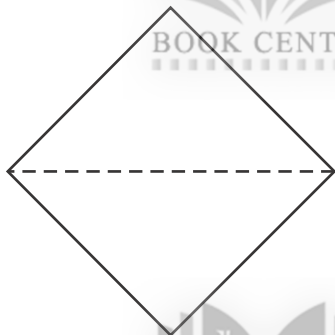
# A Spider Web

## Paper Folding and Cutting

Things you need:

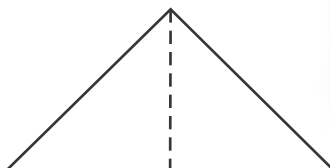


1



1. Fold paper in half diagonally. Crease it well.

2



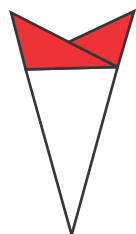
2. Fold paper in half again. Crease it well again.

3



3. Divide the triangle into 3 equal parts. Fold the right corner towards the left. Then fold the left corner over the right.

4



4. Cut straight across the top of the folded triangle. Discard the paper parts shown in red.

5



5. Cut the top of your triangle into a curve. Discard the red part. Copying the top curve, cut lines along the entire length of the triangle leaving a thin line of paper at the end of each cut. Cut as many strips as you can.

6



6. Cut out every other strip - shown in red - and save them. Carefully unfold to discover your kirigami spider web. If desired, you can gently iron to remove creases.



Use your spider webs anyway you'd like - decorate a table, string into a garland, use it in a handmade card.



# A Puzzle

Paper cutting and Pasting

Things you need:

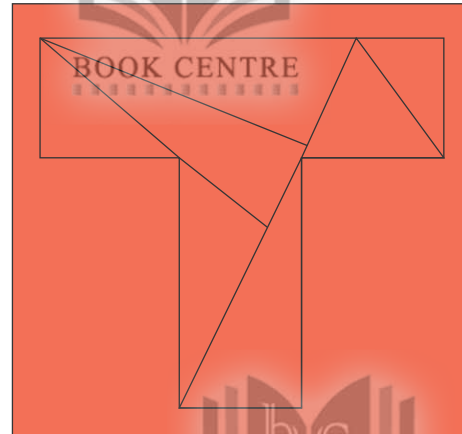

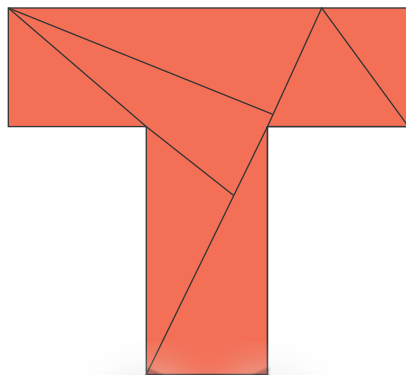
Take a piece of card board sheet.  
e.g. a shoe box. Draw a "T" as shown.

2



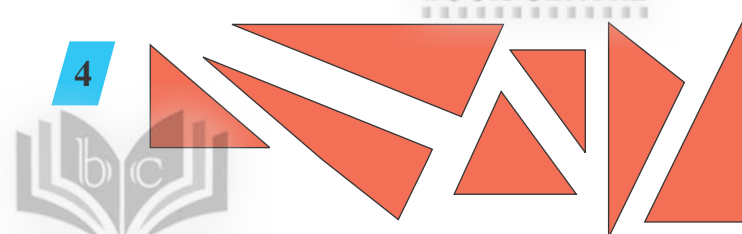
Draw or trace the puzzle on it.

3



Cut all parts cleanly.

4



Can you reassemble these triangles to make a perfect "T" again?

Hint/Tip:

When you draw the puzzle write numbers on all parts  
e.g. 1,2,3,... . Then cut them. Using your imagination  
and memory join them together again and again.  
Remember: Practice makes a man perfect.





## A Bottle Flower

Cutting and Pasting

Things you need:



1



Take an empty plastic bottle and cut the lower half.

2



Start cutting thin stripes from top to the bottom of the bottle. Leave a little margin.

3



Cut the bottle likewise. There will be many strips or needles.

4



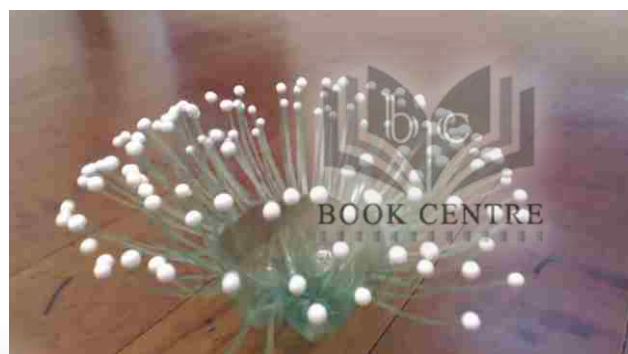
Now take wasted thermopore sheet and take out its buds by rubbing two pieces together.

5



Stick the buds on top of each needle you have cut.

6



Now spread them out and you have a lovely decoration piece.



Paper Rolling and Pasting

Things you need:



Make strips of different colours. They should be 1/4 " wide.



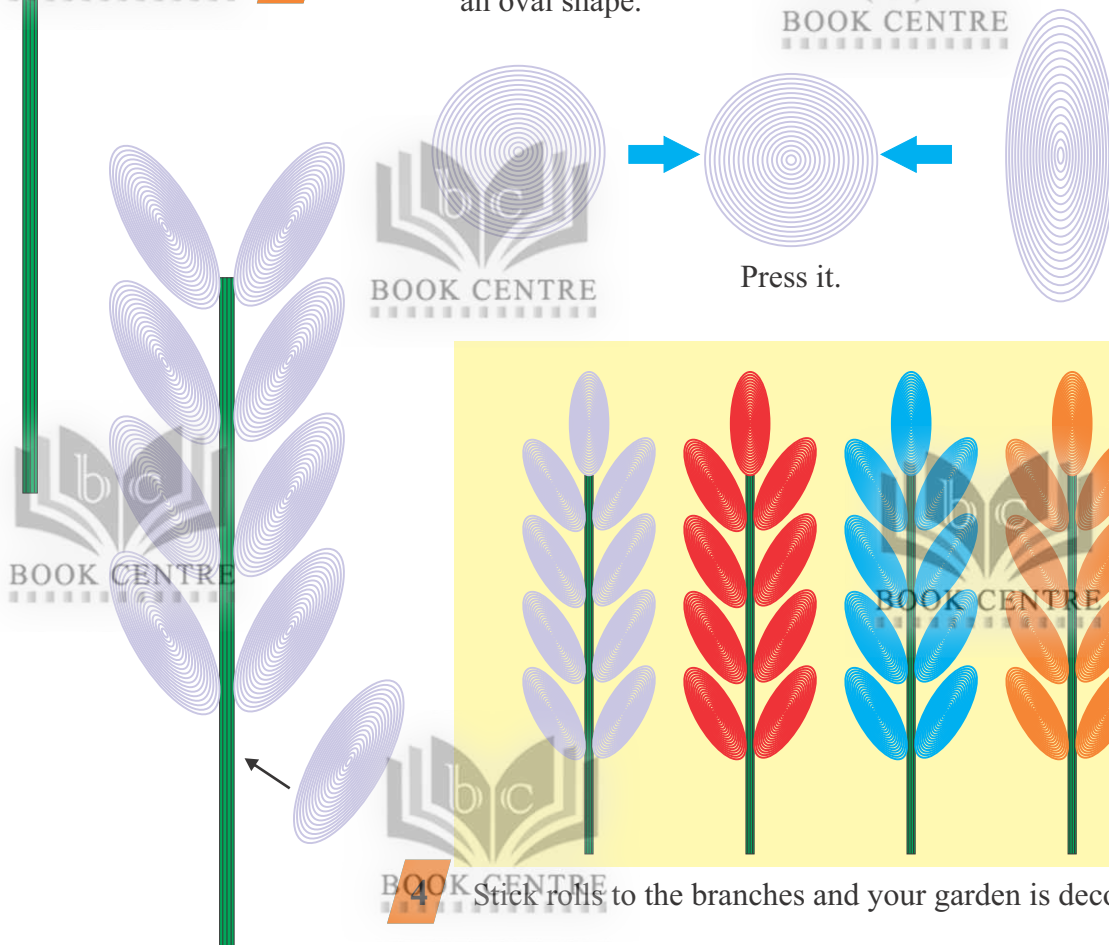
**2**

Fold green strip four times. It will be the stem.



**3**

Take different strips (Patti) of 1/4" wide of different colours. Roll the strips and squash them as shown. They will take an oval shape.



Stick rolls to the branches and your garden is decorated.
